Change in offering times and prerequisites for NEUR 410

This is the current writing intensive course in the Neuroscience major, and as the number of students has grown it has become feasible to offer it each semester. This is very desirable as students must complete NEUR 327 before they can take NEUR 410. It can make it difficult for students to graduate if a writing intensive course is not available each semester.

The pre requisites have been “cleaned up”. The program originally had NSCI as the prefix for undergraduate courses in Neuroscience, but that prefix no longer exists. NSCI was in the original proposal, but due to changes in the program has never been offered.

We are asking that NEUR 410 may be repeated for credit if the subject matter in the topics covered changes from one semester to another.
