Many students who pursue natural science majors find their first employment in Environmental Consulting. To be competitive in this field, job applicants require an interdisciplinary background (e.g., communication, policy, management) and professional consulting experience. To better prepare our graduates for this career field and to streamline the transition from the classroom into the workforce, the Department of Environmental Science and Policy proposes a minor in Environmental Consulting. The following curriculum is the result of a summer workshop where representatives from the consulting industry expressed their needs in the education of their interns and entry-level professionals. Specifically, this curriculum includes classes in communication, technical writing, applied environmental science, environmental law, and business management. The minor is finalized with a capstone course and an internship with local consulting companies.
